- On April 15, 2010, the education community lost one of its most inspiring leaders. Brian K. Betts, a consummate teacher, devoted son, brother, and loyal friend, worked on the front lines of former Chancellor Michelle A. Rhee's campaign to reform D.C. Public Schools. Brian emerged as one of the school system's most innovative principals at Shaw Middle School at Garnet-Patterson. Prior to coming to DCPS and Shaw, Mr. Betts worked for Montgomery County Public Schools in MD for 19 years as a teacher, coach, departmental chairperson, team leader, and assistant principal. In his two short years at Shaw, Mr. Betts transformed the school and changed the lives of his students, their families, and the community forever.
- The BKB foundation was established by Brian Betts' family to continue his legacy of educational enrichment for students and faculty.

- * The National Park Service (NPS) is very strict about commercial vendors displaying any merchandise or doing any promotion of their businesses. Also, on all signs, the sponsor name/logo can only be one-third the size of the race name (e.g., if the race name is 36" wide by 30" high, the sponsor name/logo can be no larger than 12" X 10"). No stand-alone signs and no canopies with the company logo allowed. Any giveaways have to be related to running or the cause or the race, such as water bottles or running caps, or something referring to education. No raffles are allowed or money exchanged.
